<p>1. Outcome evidence:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Did the research/article examine programs that address specific factors that are pertinent to your school's need(s)?</li> <li>• What outcomes were measured in the study?</li> <li>• Were the outcomes meaningful (relevant and large enough) to you and/or others in your district?</li> <li>• Who was included in this study?</li> <li>• Is it probable that other factors explain the results?</li> <li>• Was the study done in a school or setting similar to mine?</li> </ul>		
<p>2. Historical Origins:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Who developed the intervention?</li> <li>• Why was it developed?</li> </ul>		
<p>3. Pervasiveness:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How widely used is this intervention/program?</li> </ul>		
<p>4. Fiscal Costs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is the program/intervention financially feasible?</li> </ul>		

<p>5. Personnel/Staffing Implications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Does the program require new staff to be hired or will staff responsibilities need to be reallocated?</li></ul>		
<p>6. Flexibility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Is the program highly prescriptive or can it be modified without threatening program integrity?</li></ul>		
<p>7. External support: <i>(If applicable)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What type of external support is available from the developers of the program?</li></ul>
